Thank you for submitting an ALEA Volunteer Cooperative Grant Program application. The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) received 96 proposals totaling \$2.43 million in requested funds. With \$1.36 million available to award this biennium, we will fund 75 projects.

Congratulations, your project, *SFEG Volunteer Monitoring 2015-2017*, has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$16,194. If this amount is less than you originally requested, it's because the review panel voted to support the project at a reduced level.
